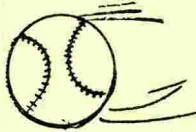

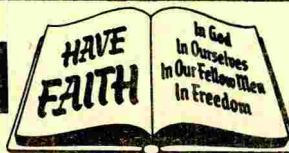

Word has been received of the death of Willis Bryant of Merced, a pioneer resident of Chatsworth who passed away last Saturday. Mr. Bryant came here in 1912, and made his home here until the early '20s, when he went into foreign service for the Shell Oil Company, and moved with his family to Sumatra. After several years in this capacity, they returned to the States and eventually made their home in Merced.

Mr. Bryant has been in ill health for several years as the result of an accident while he was working in Trinidad, an accident that ended his foreign work.

Funeral services were held in Merced Tuesday morning. He leaves his wife, Mary Brown, three sons, a daughter, and eight grandchildren.
