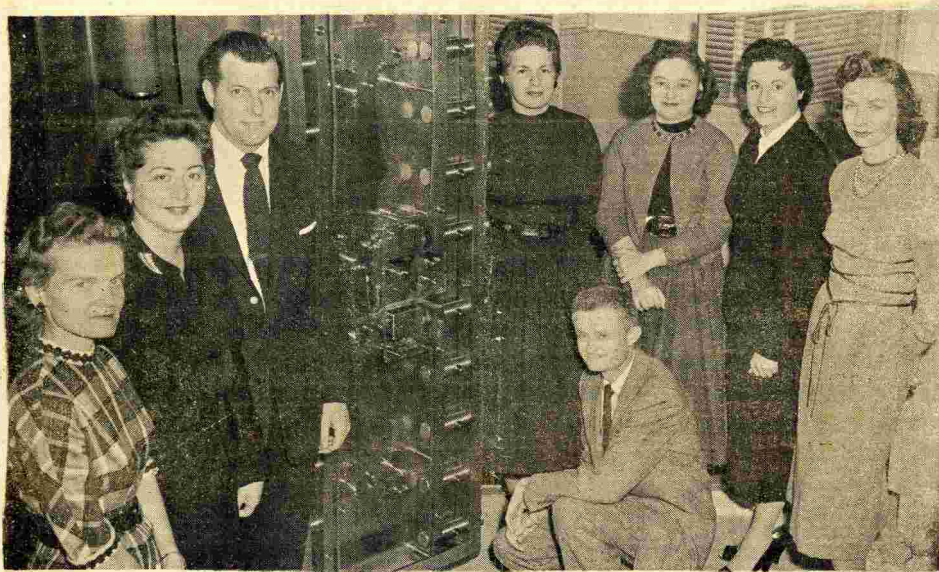

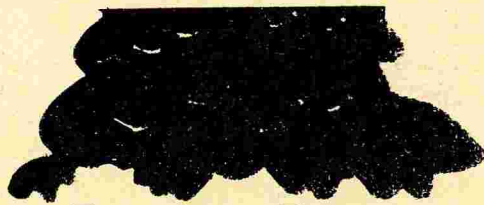

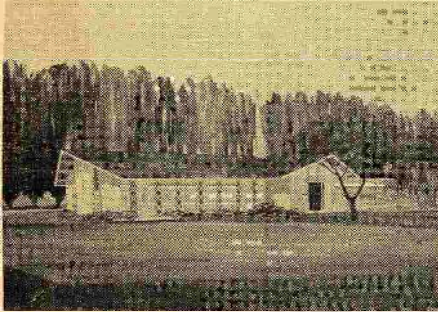

The NORTHRIDGE-CHATSWORTH 4-H CLUB recently turned out in full force on their annual project tour, planned especially that new members might see what the others

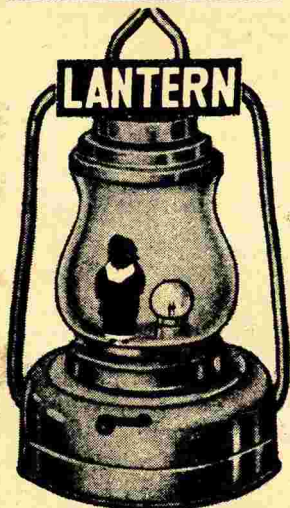
are doing and encourage them in their projects.

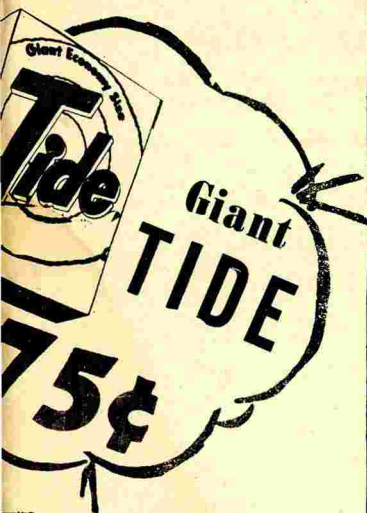

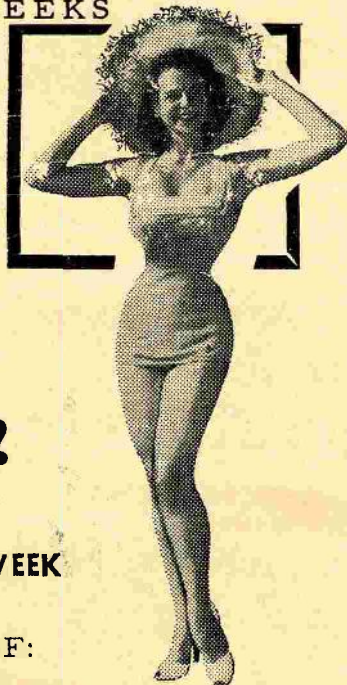

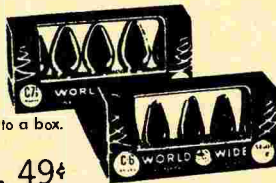
