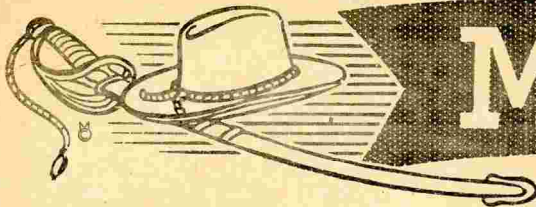

Mr. Johnson has also designed Singing Hill, Alondra Park, El Camino, El Cabellero, Burbank, The Rancho, and all of the Los Angeles courses. 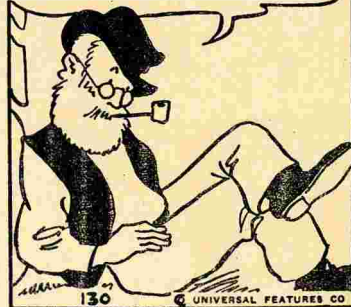
