A standby measure for the Nichols-MacDonald property which the Foundation now owns and must make a \$45,000 payment by June was the subject of of AB 949, intro-duced by Assemblyman Robert C. Cline. Currently State park funds are tied up with the Brandeis Ranch negotiations. As it stands now, funds can only be released for the Nichols-MacDonald purchase if and when the Brandeis deal is completed. Cline bill does not want to interfere with this process in any way. However, should for some reason the Brandeis aquisition not go through, if you are able to help out.
