This is to inform you of a public hearing concerning a request for Conditional Use Permit in the RPD 10,000 4 UK (Residential Planned Development-10,111 square feet minimum required area----4 dwelling units per acre) Aone to construct a 771 unit clustered flats and townhouses residential development comprised of affordable and market rate housing situated on 215.5 acres straddling both sides of the Simi Valley Freeway commencing approximately 400 feet westerly of North Topanga Canyon Boulevard in the Chatsworth Moned District of L.A. 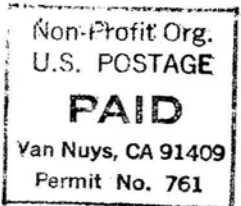
