CLUSTERING TO HELP THE PARK

Just south of Chatsworth Park South is a 55 acre parcel of land that is part of the Stagecoach Trail properties. It is not presently up for funding for acquisition and a development had been slated that would have covered most of it with housing. A new plan has just been proposed that would put in about 70 condos in a cluster on the east end of the property. This would leave the west end as open space and would hopefully eventually become part of the Park. We support this concept as it will preserve far more of the historic and scenic areas than we could have hoped for with the conventional single family type homes.

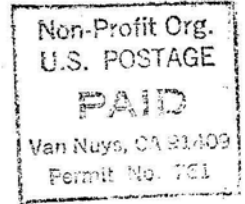
